

BYOD - Student Guidelines

- Digital devices must be used only for learning purposes, and only where reasonable and appropriate able to run Google Apps effectively
- Students will be able to use their devices only at the invitation of their teacher. A student does not have the 'right' to use their device, and is not permitted to use it, if it is against the wishes of the teacher. The teacher will make the decision on whether technology will be used in the classroom.
- All use of digital devices is covered by the *Cybersafety Use Agreement*, which all students agree to when they enrol at Upper Hutt College.
- Students are fully responsible for the care, upkeep and safe keeping of their devices. It is the owner's responsibility to repair any malfunctioning/damaged devices
- Students are responsible for the back-up of their work.
- Students must keep their device virus-free & free of spyware.
- Students need to ensure they charge their device each night as we do not want students charging their devices at school
- Student devices will connect to the Internet via the school's content filter system and no attempt is to be made to bypass the filters
- Upper Hutt College takes no responsibility for the operation or safe-keeping of students' devices and does not provide any technical support for student devices.
