<b>GENERAL STATIONERY</b>	To make best use of their device, students must have a pair of wired earphones to be able to listen individually to content on their device. These should NOT be expensive wireless earphones (eg. Air Pods or similar) but must be wired to plug into the device. <b>These can be purchased for approximately \$10.</b> Also, Ruler, Eraser, HB Pencil, Blue Pen, Red Pen, Highlighter.
<b>BYOD</b>	Students will be using their own device for learning in most of their classes. However, there are some classes where an exercise book, or other form of stationery, is still required.
